

HSi-300 on Japanese TV

The HSi-300 Agile Light Source was recently featured on NHK (Nippon Housou Kyoukai), Japan's national public broadcasting organization. On an episode of the scientific-based program *Einstein's Eye*, which was filmed at the Yamanashi Prefectural Museum of Art, a examination was performed on Jean-Francois Millet's painting, "Des Glaneuses" (the Gleaners). Rather than use the conventional mode of evaluation, such as X-ray or IR camera, the HSi-300 was used to examine the painting in hopes of giving up any secrets it may reveal. As a result of using hyperspectral technology, it was able to be determined what type of paint Millet used on his masterpiece.
